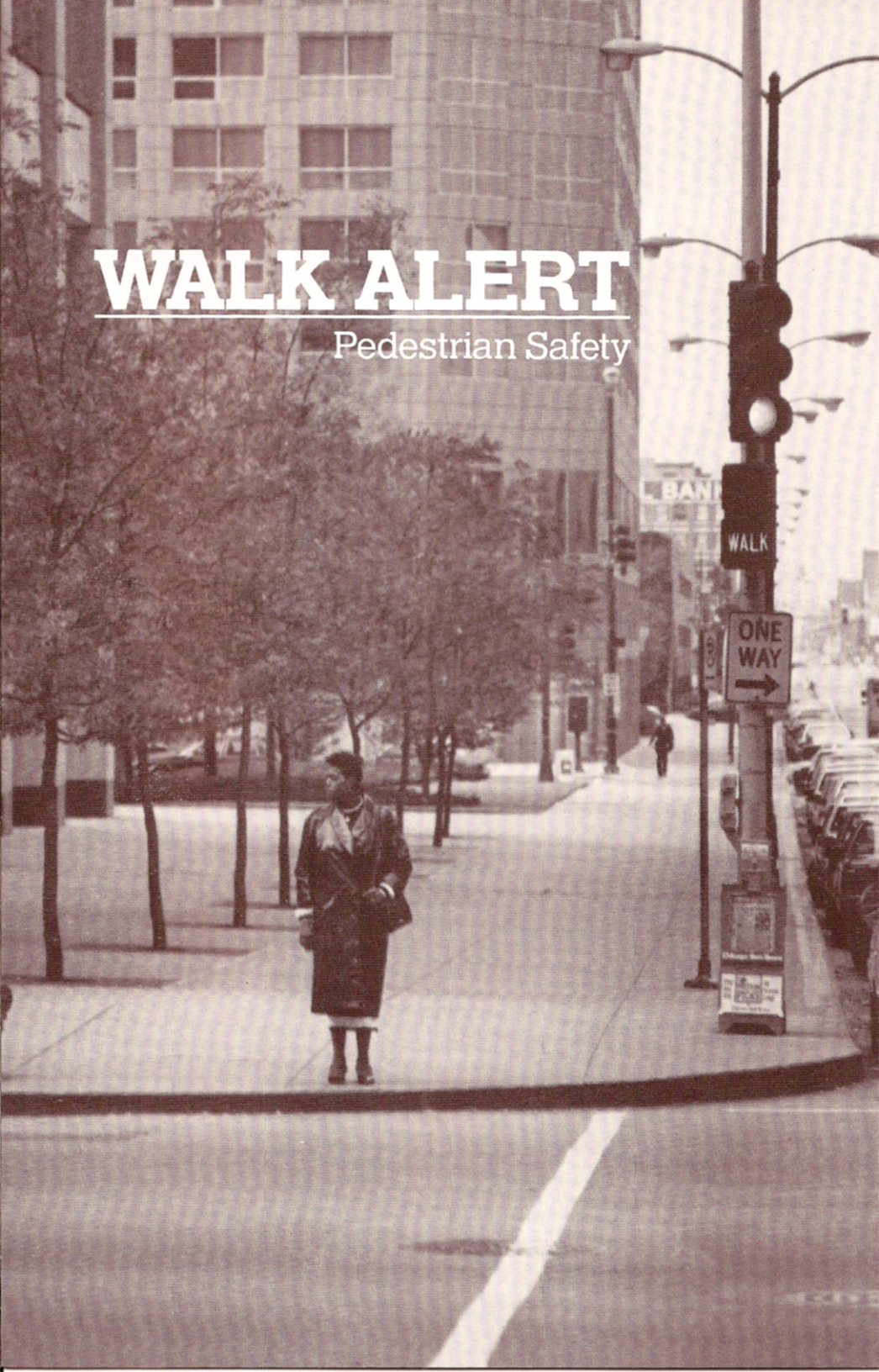


# WALK ALERT

Pedestrian Safety













## **AS A PARENT**

Teach your school-aged youngster how to safely cross the street using these simple rules:

- Always stop at the curb, edge of the road or outside edge of a parked car.
- Look left, right, and left again to see if a car is coming.
- If a car is coming, let the car pass and look left, right, and left again before crossing.

**Teach your school-aged child to cross safely.**



## **AS A DRIVER**

- When making a turn, take a last look for pedestrians.
- If an older adult is crossing at an intersection, give them a break and be patient.
- Watch out for pedestrians when backing up in parking lots or driveways.
- In residential areas, watch out for sudden dart-outs in the street by children at play.
